Executive Order 2019-06

**RELATIVE TO PROVIDING THE GUAM ETHICS COMMISSION
WITH RESOURCES TO CONDUCT ITS REQUIRED OPERATIONS**

WHEREAS, it is this Administration's priority to hold all government of Guam employees to the highest ethical standards; and

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Governor under Title 4, Chapter 15, Article 3 of the Guam Code Annotated to establish the Guam Ethics Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Ethics Commission has not been active for twenty-three (23) years; and

WHEREAS, due to its long-term inactivity, the Guam Ethics Commission did not submit a budget request for fiscal year 2019 to the Legislature for its required operations; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Ethics Commission may request and shall receive from every governmental agency cooperation and assistance in the performance of its duties; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to promptly establish the Guam Ethics Commission and immediately provide resources for its required operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSHUA F. TENORIO, *Ákto Maga'láhen Guåhan*, Acting Governor of Guam, in full consultation and coordination with **LOURDES A. LEON GUERRERO**, *Maga'hågan Guåhan*, Governor of Guam, and by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, and the laws of Guam, do order as follows:

1. The Guam Ethics Commission is hereby revived with the mission, purposes, and operational parameters as described within Title 4, Chapter 15, Articles 3 and 4.
2. The Civil Service Commission shall provide the Guam Ethics Commission with resources and the required administrative support.
